




Advocacy (Compliance Path) – Hot Topics

- 1. Are the new EUI targets/timelines achievable?
- 2. What is an achievable compliance path for a hospital with an EUI of <200 (20% reduction), 201<x<250 (30%), 251<x<300 (38%), or >300 (38%)?
- 3. How does timing of audits, scheduled equipment replacement, and central plant upgrades affect timing for compliance?

Compliance Approach – Timeline and Cumulative Budget



Benchmarking Services

Approach:

- 1. Provide outreach for benchmarking services
 - a) Leverage current relationships
 - b) How to identify and contact owners
 - c) Training materials
 - d) Connect to CAHED Portfolio Manager



Education/Training

Current Status:

- 1. Too many owners are not in the loop on policy changes, or technology and financial solutions to drive compliance
- 2. Need to provide solutions to building owners (FMs and C-Suite) to drive implementation on tight timeline.
- 3. Need to address potential negative culture behind policy/compliance approach.

Approach:

- 1. Create or collect training materials
- 2. Identify training approach (face to face, virtual)
- 3. Set up appointments and deliver training

 - Chapter 9 VMP
 - Medical Gas Pl's
 - Critical and Equipment Branch Loads
 - Surgical Smoke Evacuation



NFPA 2027 Cycle

 - NFPA 101 PI's Submitted
 - EPSS
 - Electric Vehicle Charing
 - Medical Gasses

ICC Update

- Held in Orlando last April
 - o ICC CHC
 - Submitted 14 Proposals 9 Approved
 - Supported 11 Proposals 8 Approved
 - Opposed 24 Proposals 19 Disapproved



- ABHR's Approved
 - 4 Proposals Approved as Submitted
 - Clarified location of dispensers in corridors
 - Coordinated dispenser sizes with LSC
 - Exempted need for permit if in compliance
 - Increased MAQ amounts

- Control Vestibules Approved
 - Interlocked doors in series
 - Pharmacy Compounding
 - BioLabs
- Carbon Monoxide Detection Approved
 - Rewrite of entire section
 - Cleaned up ambiguities and conflicts
 - Coordinated language with NFPA
 - Aligned changes with 2024 ICC Cycle changes



- Definition of Clinical Need Disapproved
 - Defines term to avoid confusion
 - A known care or welfare risk to care recipients that necessitates an enhanced level of safety or security
 - Committee concerns around security
- Medical Gases Approved
 - Duplicated Compressed Gas Table to Medical Gas System Section
 - Duplication of information not ideal
 - Conflicts with currently allowed amounts per NFPA 99
